- <u>Percussionists</u> must bring *everything*, *including mallets*, except for:
  - o 4 Timpani, Snare, Bass, Bells, Xylophone, Marimba, and Vibraphone
- You must bring all the other instruments, *including Baritones*

Concert Band Members Should be There to Warm-up at This Time

- Have your Judge's score and rubric ready to go!
- When everyone in your group has arrived and warmed-up sufficiently, head to *the next open* room for your instrument
  - o Rooms will be labeled, but ask the desk if you're not sure where to go
  - Parents are NOT allowed in the performance areas

## 2:15 - Start Concert Band Performances

Beginning Band Members Should be There to Warm-up at This Time

- Have your Judge's score and rubric ready to go!
- At the conclusion of your performance, leave your Judge's score and rubric with the judge, and *take everything else with you!*
- 2:30 Start Beginning Band Performances
  - After all your performances are finished, you are dismissed
  - Judge's scores, completed rubrics, and medals will be distributed in class
